Lesson 20: God is Wise

Note: The practical applications provided in the lesson are offered as suggestions to help the saints in their preparation. They are not meant to direct or limit the ways in which the focus of the lesson can be applied. The saints are encouraged to pray and contact the Lord to receive His burden and guidance in teaching and applying the lesson. Fellowship with other saints, and inquiring of the children themselves, may also bring out many helpful applications.

Level One:

Verse: "To the only wise God through Jesus Christ, to Him be the glory forever and ever.

Amen" (Rom. 16:27).

Focus: God is wise. He knows how to do everything in the best way.

Practical Application: God designed our body in the best way. Our eyes were placed above our nose—this shows God's wisdom so that we wouldn't sneeze into our eyes. God was wise to give us knees so that we could bend our legs--it would be very difficult to climb stairs without knees. God also made us with a mind to know Him and a heart to love Him.
