LEVEL ONE - Creation Lesson #7 - Plants: Seeds, Flower, Trees, Fruits

Aim/Goal:	To show the children that God made the flowers, trees and fruit on the trees. Plants start out as seeds and eventually grow into trees with flowers that produce fruit.
Bible Verse:	Genesis 1:11a "And God said, Let the earth sprout grass, herbs yielding seed, <i>and</i> fruit trees"
Bible Reference:	Genesis 1:11 "And God said, Let the earth sprout grass, herbs yielding seed, <i>and</i> fruit trees bearing fruit according to their kind with their seed in them upon the earth; and it was so."
Story Suggestion:	 Seeds can produce living things. Bring in seeds to show that from an apple seed you can grow an apple tree. Plants need something special to sustain life. Share with the children that plants need air, light and water to grow. Bring in lots of pictures and samples. Bring in samples of seeds and different fruit. Have the children guess which seeds will produce what fruit (apple, pumpkin, watermelon, avocado, etc.)
Craft /Activity Suggestion:	 Leaf Printing: (1) Ink the leaf by coating the leaf with poster paint; (2) Press the ink side of the leaf surface to a sheet/construction paper. Glue seeds to a construction paper on the bottom and show with an arrow from "seed" to "trees" to "fruit."
